GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS OF X AND XII ISSUED BY CBSE

Dear Parents,

At prestige convent school the vision of learning is comprehensive and well synchronized with the mission to prepare global citizens, empowered with values and virtues. Our empowered students of class X & XII are ready to embark on their journey to explore the vast horizon of success and glory. We wish them all the best for their forthcoming board exams.

You are requested to keep note of the following important points and guide your children to strictly adhere to these guidelines given by CBSE.

1. Report at the exam centre latest by 10:00 a.m. Entry is not permitted after 10:00 a.m.
2. Parents should visit their examination centre prior to the examination to confirm the location, distance, traffic condition, etc. They should leave their home much in advance so that they can reach examination centre as per schedule and on time.
3. You are suggested to download the exam centre locator app- **CBSE ECL APP**, is an android based mobile app which can be used by students to locate their examination centre and see the distance between current location and examination centre. The **CBSE ECL APP** is available on the **Google Play store**.
4. No candidate will be allowed to leave the examination centre before the examination is over.
5. Students should carry only Blue/Royal blue ball point/Gel/Fountain pen, pencil, eraser, sharpener, geometry instruments, colors, brushes, **Admit card (Roll no.) duly signed by Student, Parent and Principal, as per requirement in a transparent pouch only.**
6. They should not carry mobile, other electronic items and the barred items like any Printed/Written material, Food items/Snacks inside the examination hall (some exceptions to diabetic students).
7. Students will go only in the complete school uniform with their **School Identity Card** for appearing in the examination
8. They will follow all the instructions given to them by the invigilators.
9. They will complete entries on answer book and on question paper correctly and neatly.
10. They will not indulge in any unfair practices. If found they will be booked under unfair means activities and action will be taken accordingly.
11. They should not believe in fake videos and messages uploaded on the social media regarding leakage of question paper or forward them. They should not give ear to rumors and they should not spread rumors too.
12. In case, there is any ambiguity found in question paper they will bring to the notice of their school for informing the same to the CBSE.
13. Students must ensure cleanliness and maintain discipline in the examination centre.
14. Students should write their Roll No. correctly in Answer Book as per the guidelines printed overleaf.
